BACKGROUND -

RECOMMENDATION -

On December 2, 1996, by Roll Call No. 96-4043, the City Council approved an Urban Renewal Development Agreement with ABC Partners, L.P. The City agreed to provide economic development grants in a total amount not to exceed \$2,662,500 in exchange for the Developer providing the private financing and construction of the streets, sewers and other public infrastructure necessary to permit the development of the Airport Business Park Urban Renewal Project Area.

In September, the Council expanded the Airport Business Park Urban Renewal Project Area to add additional land lying immediately east of the original area. The additional loan will be developed in common with the original project area.

This amendment expands the project area within which the Developer can construct the necessary infrastructure and obtain reimbursement. This allows the expanded area to be developed as one large planned area, not as two smaller units.

Although the project area will expand significantly, the maximum economic development grant available to the Developer will remain the same.
