	BACKGROUND -
	On August 31, 2000, by Roll Call No. 00-3634, the City Council
	approved a Predesign Agreement (Agreement No. 2001-P-028) with
	IDOT for I-235, from the west city limits to the north city limits.
	IDOT has completed the design of the storm and sanitary sewer. The
	project name is the Maple Street Storm and Sanitary Sewer, and the

work includes the construction of storm and sanitary sewer along Maple Street north of I-235.

The Maple Street Storm and Sanitary Sewer Agreement has been negotiated with IDOT to identify the responsibilities of IDOT and the City regarding the administration, funding, and implementation of the project construction, as well as future maintenance responsibility of City facilities such as storm and sanitary sewers. Construction is in spring 2002, and IDOT is responsible for notification of all future closures. IDOT must approve this document before work may begin.
