GRANT **APPLICATION BACKGROUND -TYPE:** The City of Des Moines Municipal Housing Agency has received funding since 1996 from HUD for a Service Coordinator for Elderly **RESOLUTION** and Disabled Persons. **RECEIVE/FILE** The grant provides funds to employ a Service Coordinator who assists clients in obtaining and maintaining needed support services, such as housekeeping, home health care, and Meals on Wheels. Additionally, **SUBMITTED BY:** the Service Coordinator provides residents with educational programs MIKE MATTHES and procures services to allow residents to continue to live ACTING DIRECTOR independently. **DES MOINES** MUNICIPAL Funds are available through HUD to renew last year's grant. The City will provide a mandated 25 percent match consisting of in-kind HOUSING AGENCY services.
