The Police Department requests the Council grant approval for the Mayor to sign said annual maintenance agreement as the City representative. The agreement begins May 1, 2002 and will expire on April 30, 2003.

CHIEF OF POLICE	BACKGROUND -
	By Roll Call No. 97-2875, the City Council approved a \$124,000 purchase of a Printrak Automated Fingerprint Workstation. This workstation allows the Police Department to quickly peruse the State Department of Criminal Investigation's fingerprint database. By Roll Call No. 99-214, the Council approved a \$143,050 purchase of a LiveScan 2000 Fingerprint Processor. This machine allows staff to take electronic fingerprints and digital mug shots, which can be processed and reviewed more efficiently. This machine also allows fingerprint data to be directly delivered to the state database for storage and future use.

Both the warranties and initial maintenance agreements associated with these machines have expired. Printrak has provided a combined maintenance contract for both systems. Software upgrades, hardware repair and system configuration issues are covered by the new agreement.
