**BACKGROUND** -

The City of Des Moines entered into a boundary roads maintenance agreement with Warren County on November 7, 1993, to divide the maintenance responsibilities for various roads which constitute the boundary line between the City and County. The first addendum to this agreement, entered into on December 18, 1995, amended the list of roads subject to the agreement. This proposed second addendum again amends the list of roads subject to the agreement due to the voluntary annexation of property in northern Warren County.
