The Department of Housing Services is a participant in the Section 5(h) Affordable Homeownership Program which was approved on May 30, 2000, by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). Under this program, single-family homes in the public housing inventory are sold to eligible housing program participants.

A housing program participant has made application with Neighborhood Finance Corporation (NFC) to purchase 3010 Cleveland, Des Moines.

The appraised price of the property is \$60,000. The projected loan amount is \$40,200, with a second mortgage in the amount of \$19,800.
