On April 26, 2002, three bids were opened regarding a year-to-year lease agreement for the farmland located between the James W.

Cownie Soccer Park and the Des Moines River in the vicinity of 22nd

Street and Hartford Avenue.

Bids were received from Mike Christenson, Doug George, and Roscoe Rush. Mike Christenson of Christenson Farms was deemed to be the high bidder for the property and was awarded the lease.

The lease agreement is a year-to-year agreement, but expires under its own terms November 1, 2004.
