	BACKGROUND -
	On August 31, 2000, by Roll Call No. 00-3634, the City Council
	approved a Predesign Agreement (Agreement No. 2001-P-028) with
	IDOT for I-235, from the west city limits to the north city limits.
	IDOT has completed the design of the bridge reconstruction. The
	project name is the 2nd Avenue and 3rd Street Bridge Reconstruction,
	and the work includes the relocation and reconstruction of bridges and

streets in the vicinity of the interchange and intersection with I-235.

The 2nd Avenue and 3rd Street Bridge Reconstruction Agreement has been negotiated with IDOT to identify the responsibilities of IDOT and the City regarding the administration, funding, and implementation of the project construction, as well as future maintenance responsibility of City facilities such as structures serving roadways. Construction is in 2002, and IDOT is responsible for notification of all future closures. IDOT must approve this document before work may begin.
