# BACKGROUND -

#### **SUBMITTED BY:**

DONALD M. TRIPP PARK AND RECREATION DIRECTOR The Park and Recreation Department and the City of Des Moines' Street Use Team jointly recommend revising ordinances 14-117 and 102-1123 to exclude permits for timed athletic events and street use permits for events and activities that occur entirely within a City park.

With the completion of the trail at Gray's Lake Park, several events (i.e., charity walks and runs) have requested the use of Gray's Lake Park over City streets. The Park and Recreation Department follows the same procedures as the City's Street Use Team to evaluate the event organizer's implementation plan and assist in ensuring all necessary permits and ordinances are followed.

The exception recommended above will eliminate a duplication in the

existing process and allow for better customer service to event organizers desirous to host their event within a City park.
