SYNOPSIS -

A 28E Agreement is being submitted for approval and signed to allow the Police and Fire Departments to share public safety data with other public safety agencies in Polk County.

BACKGROUND -

The E911 Service Board has approved funds to be utilized to purchase the COPLINK software and hardware program. This will allow timely sharing of all public safety data to all participating agencies which are Ankeny Police/Fire, Des Moines Police/Fire, West Des Moines Police/Fire, Clive Police/Fire, Urbandale Police/Fire and the Polk County Sheriff (including all agencies that Polk County Sheriff dispatches).
