KIMM, INC. **BACKGROUND** -TYPE: The Upper Union Park Watershed is located in the north central **RESOLUTION** portion of Des Moines along the east bank of the Des Moines River. ORDINANCE The watershed covers approximately 240 acres of intense residential RECEIVE/FILE development and includes portions of the Union Park and Highland Park Neighborhoods. **SUBMITTED BY:** An inadequate combined sanitary/storm sewer system and an old and undersized storm sewer system currently handle the rainfall runoff from the area. A Professional Services Agreement in the amount of \$454,790 for the design of the improvements in accordance with the Conceptual Design Report was approved by the City Council on March 12, 2001.

All design work for Phase I under the original consultant agreement has been completed and bids have been received for the Phase I construction contract. Award of the construction contract is being considered at this Council meeting as another agenda item.

This supplemental agreement provides for Veenstra & Kimm, Inc. to provide construction phase engineering services for Phase 1 of the Upper Union Park Sewer Separation Project.
