The Community Development Department submitted an application to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for Supportive Housing Program (SHP) funds to provide services to homeless persons in Des Moines and Polk County. HUD has now forwarded the second of two SHP grant agreements that require Council approval.

The \$306,651 of SHP funds, which the Community Development Department will administer, will be utilized by the YMCA -Transitional Housing Project to assist homeless residents. The City will retain \$7,301 (approximately 2.4 percent of the total award) of the grant funds for administrative costs.

**BACKGROUND** -

On behalf of the City, the Community Development Department applied for two Supportive Housing grants and One Shelter Plus Care grant which included the geographic areas of the City of Des Moines and Polk County in the amount of \$1,860,406. All three projects were awarded funding. As the applicant, the City is responsible for the overall management and administration of the grant, including drawdowns, fund distribution, and reporting to HUD. The City and the two agencies receiving SHP funds will share 5 percent of the SHP portion of the total grant amount for administration costs.

Project sponsors will carry out the following activities:

- · House of Mercy Transitional Housing Project (SHP renewal) will provide transitional housing and support services for homeless, alcohol and drug dependent pregnant and or parenting mothers as approved by Council on April 8, 2002 (Roll Call No. 02-871).
- · YMCA Transitional Housing Project (SHP renewal) will provide transitional housing and support services for homeless single adult males.
- · Anawim Housing (Shelter + Care renewal) will provide permanent supportive housing for homeless persons with disabilities as approved by Council on March 18, 2002 (Roll Call No. 02-703).
