The Department of Housing Services is a participant in the Section 5(h) Affordable Homeownership Program which was approved on May 30, 2000, by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). Under this program, single-family homes in the public housing inventory are sold to eligible housing program participants.

A housing program participant has made application with U.S. Bank to purchase 4024 Briarcliff, Des Moines.

The appraised price of the property is \$93,000. The projected loan amount is \$62,310 with a second mortgage in the amount of \$30,690.
