TRIPP PARK AND RECREATION DIRECTOR	The Polk County Conservation Board has retained Dunbar-Jones Partnership of Des Moines to provide professional planning services for the completion of a Park Master Plan for Easter Lake Park. Since Ewing Park and Easter Lake Park have a common boundary and essentially are geographically contiguous, the two Parks should be master planned concurrently. A concurrent master planning effort will provide continuity in planning uses and amenities for neighbors and potential users to provide a more efficient use of resources and avoid duplication of facilities.
	It also recommended that the services of a landscape architect consultant for the Ewing Park Master Plan be exempted from the competitive bidding and advertisement requirements for good cause shown, pursuant to Section 2-725(g) of the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines.
