	BACKGROUND —
SUBMITTED BY: PHILLIP C. VORLANDER FIRE CHIEF	On February 12, 2001, by Roll Call No. 01-405, the City Council approved a contract between the City of Des Moines and Team Two Inc. to provide ambulance billing services for the fire department. The contract provided compensation of 8% on collected monies resulting from the ambulance service. The contract also provided for a 30-day termination notice for both parties and a contract period to run from February 12, 2001 to June 30, 2003 with two (2) one-year renewal options.
	On December 18, 2002 by Roll Call No. 03-3007 the City Council approved an increase in base ambulance rates from \$400 to \$500. As a result of the increase in ambulance rates and no commensurate increase in their workload, the Vendor has agreed to a reduction of fees for billing services from 8% of gross revenues to 6% of gross revenues. The 6% rate will commence with transports occurring on March 1, 2003.
	The City is also requesting an amendment to increase from 30-day to 90-day written notification of termination of contract on the part of
	both the Vendor and the City. The Vendor desires the City's approval to place an additional one-
	year extension to the contract to terminate on June 30, 2006 by

mutual agreement of both parties.
All other sections of the contract shall remain in force.
