SYNOPSIS —

Approval of a City sponsorship of a \$200,000 pass-through grant for drug prevention activities operated by Rock In Prevention.

FISCAL IMPACT —

RECOMMENDATION —

BACKGROUND —

Rock In Prevention is requesting the City sponsor a \$200,000 pass-through grant. The grant will enable Rock In Prevention to continue a drug prevention program that is currently operating in 15 Des Moines schools.

The program trains high school students to work with elementary age children on drug prevention strategies. The money comes from the Byrne program through the Department of Justice.

The program will run from July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2004, and requires the City to be the sponsor.
