SYNOPSIS —

Requesting approval for submission of grant application for the Family Self-Sufficiency Program to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), and authorization for the Mayor to execute and the City Manager to implement grant if awarded.

FISCAL IMPACT —

Grant application is for \$108,740 over a one-year period.

RECOMMENDATION —

Approval.

BACKGROUND —

The City of Des Moines Municipal Housing Agency received funding last year from HUD for a full-time program coordinator to administer a Family Self-Sufficiency Program for Section 8 clients.

The program coordinator provides individual case management to assist clients in achieving goals to become self-sufficient, including training, education, and job development skills.

HUD requires that the Housing Agency administer a Family Self-Sufficiency Program for Section 8 clients, and the Agency has provided a program since 1985.

Funds are available through HUD to renew last year's grant and to add an additional program coordinator to assist with the development of homeownership opportunities for Section 8 families. The grant will cover the salary and fringe benefits for two full-time program coordinators.
