SYNOPSIS —

Authorization to sell a public housing single-family unit to a former housing program participant.

FISCAL IMPACT —

Revenue derived from the sale of the property goes into the Section 5(h) Operating Budget to cover program costs. The Housing Services Department will net approximately \$50,920 after seller costs are paid. The second mortgage in the amount of approximately \$25,080 is, by program guidelines, held in abeyance for seven (7) years. If the owner goes the full seven (7) year term, the second mortgage is forgiven.

RECOMMENDATION —

Approval.

BACKGROUND —

The Department of Housing Services is a participant in the Section 5(h) Affordable Homeownership Program which was approved on May 30, 2000, by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development. Under this program, single-family homes in the public housing inventory are sold to eligible housing program participants.

A former housing program participant has made application with US Bank for a loan to purchase 2729 Scott Street, Des Moines.

The appraised price of the property is \$76,000. The projected loan amount is \$50,920 with a second mortgage in the amount of \$25,080.
