FISCAL IMPACT — Total compensation to the consultant is not to exceed \$40,000. Funding will be from the WRA Renewal and Replacement Fund, Activity ID 01-2003-027, EN267, ENG990000, WRA069. The fund will have an FY04 projected beginning balance of \$11,755,988. The portion of the fee allocated to the City of Des Moines is approximately \$25,140.

CITY ENGINEER	The WRA Management Agency has, through its Governance Committee, undertaken a study of its governance structure and has recommended that the improvements to be constructed pursuant to the Facilities Plan Update should be financed and constructed under a Two-Tier Utility concept, and has further recommended that new communities hereafter admitted to membership in the WRA be required to make a capital contribution to current members in the form of surcharge payments. The Governance Committee has recommended the retention of a financial consultant to study the financing of such improvements under the Two-Tier Utility concept, and to make recommendations regarding the capital contribution to be required of new communities admitted to membership in the WRA.
