Execute all agreements acknowledgements regarding grant and contributions. SUBMITTED BY: DONALD M. TRIPP BACKGROUND -PARK AND RECREATION Since 1993, the Evelyn K. Davis Summer Day Camp Program has served DIRECTOR over 1,100 youth from 5 - 18 years of age. Typically, 100 youth from the Enterprise Community attend the Day Camp on an annual basis. The purpose of the program is to provide a safe haven for learning, positive interaction, and enrichment activities which will enhance opportunities to increase self-esteem and encourage positive peer and counselor relations. Cost for the Evelyn K. Davis Summer Day Camp Program for the summer of 2003 is budgeted at \$63,420, including \$20,000 from private foundations and \$7,120 in grants as outlined in this communication, \$10,000 through the AmeriCorps Program, \$9,100 in security provided by the City and \$17,200 of in-kind support from several cooperating Agencies. AmeriCorps members and junior counselors provide structured activities from 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. for a nine-week period. This program employs youth ages 14-18 offering valuable management and leadership experience for

CITY COUNCIL COMMUNICATION 03-302 JUNE 23, 2003 PAGE TWO	The previous funding source for the 15 junior counselors was the Iowa Comprehensive Human Services Summer Youth Employment Program. The federal dollars administered by Polk County were eliminated. The Des Moines Park and Recreation Department received notification on May 27, 2003.
	The Summertime Grant Program was last available to staff in 2000 and was reactivated in April 2003. Staff received notification and quickly responded to the announcement of the grant opportunity to meet the April 28 deadline with a \$10,000 request. A grant was awarded in the amount of \$7,120 on June 5, 2003. Grant dollars are used for general camp expenses including field trips and supply expenses.
	At this time, staff is recommending that the City Council ratify and confirm the grant agreement and agree to abide by the terms and conditions of the said grant, a copy of which is on file with the City Clerk. Staff will present a final report of this grant activity by September 30, 2003 in compliance with the agreement.
