Under this program, single-family homes in the public housing inventory are sold to eligible housing program participants. A housing program participant has made application with US Bank for a loan to purchase 4617 SE 7th St., Des Moines.
	The appraised price of the property is \$92,000. The projected loan amount is \$61,640 with a second mortgage in the amount of \$30,360.
