MERRILL R. STANLEY FINANCE DIRECTOR	As a result of an RFP issued in November 1999, CBE was selected as the City's collection services agency with a contract start date of March 1, 2000. The contract period was for three years with two one-year renewal options. The City exercised its first one-year renewal option to extend the contract with CBE until March 1, 2004. The contract may be terminated by either party with thirty (30) days written notice. The City currently forwards to CBE delinquent ambulance accounts and Municipal Housing Services' delinquent rent accounts. The City would like to see improvements in collection rates for these accounts and would also like to add new types of accounts to be sent to a collection agency. Specifically, the City is interested in receiving collection services for unpaid parking tickets. Our current collection agency cannot provide this service based on the information the City can furnish for each unpaid ticket. The City may want to select collection agencies that specialize in the collection of delinquent ambulance accounts or unpaid parking tickets.
	The City reserves the right to select one or more collection agencies as a result of the RFP process if it is in the City's best interest to select agencies that specialize in a specific type of account.

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
