#### SYNOPSIS -

A new 28E agreement has been created by the City of Des Moines to continue the School Resource Officer Program with the Des Moines Independent School District. If approved by the City Council, the agreement will be forwarded to the School District for approval.

#### FISCAL IMPACT —

\$558,615

The City and School District will share costs at a rate of 50 percent each for Fiscal Year (FY) 2004 and FY2005. For FY2006, FY2007, FY2008, and FY2009, the City's share will be 40 percent and the School District share will be 60 percent. The City and the School District will share equally in any grant revenue.

To offset the cost of this program, the City of Des Moines applied for a COPS in Schools grant and has been informed that the application was approved.

### **RECOMMENDATION** —

Approval of the 28E Agreement to continue the School Resource Officer Program.

#### BACKGROUND —

On January 4, 1999, by Roll Call No. 99-098, the Council adopted the implementation of a School Resource Officer Program.

On June 9, 2003, by Roll Call No. 03-85, the Council approved the grant application for COPS in Schools grant.

On June 9, 2003, by Roll Call No. 03-85A, the Council terminated the agreement with the School District to end the School Resource Officer Program.
