Under this program, single-family homes in the public housing inventory are sold to eligible housing program participants.
	An eligible buyer has made application with Iowa State Bank for a loan to purchase 205 SE Livingston, Des Moines.
	The appraised price of the property is \$96,000. The projected loan amount is \$64,320 with a second mortgage in the amount of \$31,680.
