## OFFICE OF THE CITY MANAGER CITY OF DES MOINES, IOWA

SYNOPSIS —

The Iowa Department of Transportation (IDOT) has proposed an agreement between the City of Des Moines and the IDOT for E. 30<sup>th</sup> Street Resurfacing from Dean Avenue to Maple Street.

The construction costs are eligible for reimbursement by IDOT Surface Transportation Program (STP) Funds, up to a maximum of \$105,000. The City of Des Moines will provide matching funding for construction, design and construction administration services. Total City funding is estimated to be \$195,000.

FISCAL IMPACT —

The total estimated project cost is \$300,000. The funding for this project is available in the current Capital Improvements Program Budget, Index Code 486142, Account 543060, Fund CP038, Organization ENG990000, Project STR209 – East 30<sup>th</sup> Street Resurfacing – Dean Avenue to East University Avenue.

**RECOMMENDATION** —

Approval.

**BACKGROUND** —

On November 6, 2000, by Roll Call Number 00-4291, the City Council authorized the City Manager to submit an application to IDOT for STP funds for resurfacing E. 30<sup>th</sup> Street from Dean Avenue to Maple Street. This funding request was subsequently approved, and IDOT has prepared an agreement for the proposed improvement, which consists of milling the existing surface and resurfacing with hot mix asphalt. The work is scheduled for summer 2004.
