Reallocation of \$4,800 of Weed & Seed funding from the Executive Office for Weed & Seed (EOWS).

SYNOPSIS—

City Council approval of the reallocation of \$4,800 of Weed & Seed funding from the Executive Office for Weed & Seed (EOWS).

BACKGROUND—

On May 20, 2002, by Roll Call No. 02-1280, the City Council authorized submitting an application for 2002-2003 Executive Office for Weed & Seed (EOWS) funding in the amount of \$175,000.

On June 9, 2003, by Roll Call No. 03-1321, Council approved and accepted a grant award of \$175,000 of Weed & Seed funding from the Executive Office for Weed & Seed and authorized and directed the City Manager to approve and execute the detailed work programs and written

agreements with sub-recipient entities implementing all projects as reflected in Exhibit A (attached to the roll call), which included an allocation of \$24,480 of Weed & Seed funding for four (4) Police Department Neighborhood Based Service Delivery (NBSD) Officers.

The Police Department has requested the transfer of \$4,800 of Weed & Seed funding allocated for their NBSD Officers to the John R. Grubb YMCA Weed & Seed Community Activities Project as reflected in Revised Exhibit A (attached to the roll call).
