SUBJECT—

Authorization to Proceed on Various City-Wide Stormwater Utility Projects.

SYNOPSIS—

Authorization to proceed with public stormwater improvement projects, including design and commencement of right-of-way determination and acquisition in accordance with City Council policy, at four (4) locations within the City: 44th Street and Forest Ave. Sewer Separation; SE 20th Street from E Market Street to Scott Avenue Stormwater Improvements; SW 9th Street and Luster Lane Culvert Repair; and E 16th Street and E Sheridan Avenue Stormwater Improvements. This authorization shall include the procurement of design services by a qualified engineering consulting firm for the E 16th Street and E Sheridan Avenue Stormwater Improvements project.

FISCAL IMPACT—

Stormwater Utility Funds, City-Wide Stormwater Utility Projects: Account: 543030, Fund: EN304, Organization: PWK990000, Project: STE057, Activity IDs: 08-2004-006; 08-2004-009; 08-2004-008; 08-2004-007 44th Street and Forest Ave. Sewer Separation (Activity ID 08-2004-006) is estimated at \$100,000. SE 20th Street from E Market Street to Scott Avenue Stormwater Improvements (Activity ID 08-2004-009) is estimated at \$150,000. SW 9th Street and Luster Lane Culvert Repair (Activity ID 08-2004-008) is estimated at \$90,000. E 16th Street and E Sheridan Ave. Stormwater Improvements (Activity ID 08-2004-007) is estimated at \$250,000.

BACKGROUND—

These projects will upgrade drainage facilities in the respective areas and will improve the service and the ability to maintain the effected storm sewer systems. It is anticipated construction of these projects will require minor amounts of right-of-way acquisitions on all projects, with the exception of the SE 20th Street from E Market Street to Scott Avenue Stormwater Improvements project.
