SUBJECT—

Traffic Regulation Changes

SYNOPSIS—

The following traffic regulation change has been reviewed by staff and is recommended for approval.

- A. Parking Restriction Modifications Due to New Construction—2nd Avenue between Court Avenue and Vine Street.

FISCAL IMPACT—

Minor costs for signing and parking meters to be paid from the Traffic and Transportation operating budget.

RECOMMENDATION—

Approval

BACKGROUND—

- A. The Traffic and Transportation Division has reviewed the area on 2nd Avenue from Court Avenue to Vine Street to adjust parking in this area in accordance with the street reconstruction and adjacent business/residential construction. The following recommended ordinance changes will implement existing parking restrictions that facilitate the operation of the Polk County Juvenile Center and redefine the limits for the existing parking meter and restricted parking areas on the west side of the street..

Sec. 114-2586. Second Avenue--Vine Street to Walnut Street.

Second Avenue, on the west side, from a point 180 feet south of Court Avenue to a point 70 feet south thereof, is designated juvenile court officials parking only and is subject to the same prohibition as is found in section 114-615 of this code.

- Second Avenue, on the west side, from a point 250 feet south of Court Avenue to a point 70 feet south thereof, no parking any time.

- Sec. 114-3861. Second Avenue—Vine Street to Court Avenue.

- ~~Second Avenue, on the west side, from a point 125 feet south of Court Avenue to a point 75~~ 120 feet south thereof, two-hour meters, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

- Second Avenue, on the west side, from a point 320 feet south of Court Avenue to Vine Street, two-hour meters, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
