SUBJECT—

Ordinance amendments regarding the general penalty and reckless driving, and enacting new ordinances regarding operators license, careless driving, and work zone regulations.

SYNOPSIS-

Establishing City ordinances for the following traffic violations:

- 1. Road work zone violations
- 2. No drivers license
- 3. Expired drivers license
- 4. Unlawful use of license
- 5. Permitting unauthorized minor to drive
- 6. Permitting unauthorized person to drive
- 7. Careless Driving

This action also includes updating the misdemeanor violation language.

FISCAL IMPACT—

A potential annual increase in revenue is estimated at \$175,000.00 - \$200,000.00.



RECOMMENDATION—

BACKGROUND—

The revisions contained in these ordinances are recommended to accomplish the following:

- 1. Increase safety for the residents of Des Moines on I-235 through compliance with speed restrictions.
- 2. Increase safety for construction workers on the I-235 project.
- 3. Offset costs associated with enforcement action for speeding and drivers license violations.
- 4. Establish traffic ordinances in the City of Des Moines to mirror that of other jurisdictions (State, County, and Cities).
