### SUBJECT—

Authorization to Proceed and Authorization to Acquire Right-of-Way for the City-Wide Storm Sewer Lining project.

### SYNOPSIS—

Council authorization to proceed with design work and authorization to acquire right-of-way is being requested for the City-Wide Storm Sewer Lining project at four (4) locations within the City: SW 23<sup>rd</sup> Street west of Fleur Drive, Martin Luther King, Jr. Parkway at 17<sup>th</sup> Street, Martin Luther King, Jr. Parkway at Bennett Avenue, and west of East 30<sup>th</sup> Street south of Easton Boulevard.

### FISCAL IMPACT—

Funding for these projects is estimated at \$200,000 and is included in the 2004-2005 Storm Sewer Improvements Capital Improvements Program (CIP): EN304; PWK990000; STE057 (Page SSI-5), Activity ID 08-2005-004.

### RECOMMENDATION—

Approval

**BACKGROUND—**

This project will line deteriorated storm drainage pipes in the respective areas and will improve the safety, service, and maintainability of the affected storm sewer systems. It is anticipated construction of this project will require two or three access and temporary construction easements.
