SUBJECT—

Hearing for the vacation and conveyance of excess right-of-way on 36th Street south of Douglas Avenue.

SYNOPSIS—

This action would approve the vacation and conveyance of the above referenced property to Jerry D. Lohner at $3500 - 36^{th}$ Street, south of Douglas Avenue.

FISCAL IMPACT—

The sale of this property is expected to yield \$600.00. The proceeds of the sale of this property will be deposited into the Property Management Endowment Fund as follows: Account: 480010; Fund: SP767; Organization: PKS161625; Project: PM-003.

BACKGROUND—

On October 22, 2001, by Roll Call 01-3179, the City Council approved a recommendation from City Plan and Zoning Commission for vacation and conveyance of a portion of 36th Street right-of-way adjoining property owned by Jerry D. Lohner at 3500 – 36th Street, south of Douglas Avenue.

This property measures 252' x 40'. The Traffic and Transportation Division of the Engineering Department has determined that the property is not needed for any planned or anticipated street or highway expansion projects.

Jerry D. Lohner, $3500 - 36^{th}$ Street, Des Moines, Iowa, 50310-4632, has submitted an offer to purchase in the amount of \$600.00 for the sale of the above referenced property, which is equal to the estimated fair market value. The Buyer will incorporate the vacated right-of-way to his adjoining property for purposes of re-platting for single-family residential development.
