SUBJECT—

Approving and authorizing the execution of the Iowa Department of Transportation (IDOT) Agreement for Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway and 19th Street Resurfacing from University Avenue to Mondamin Avenue.

SYNOPSIS-

The Iowa Department of Transportation has proposed an agreement with the City of Des Moines for the Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway and 19th Street Resurfacing from University Avenue to Mondamin Avenue. The total estimated project cost is \$550,000.

The construction costs are eligible for 80% reimbursement by IDOT Surface Transportation Program (STP) Funds, up to a maximum of \$364,000. The City of Des Moines will provide matching funding for construction, design and construction administration services.

FISCAL IMPACT—

Total City funding is estimated to be \$186,000. Funding for this project is available in the Capital Improvements Program Budget, Account 543060, Fund CP038, Organization ENG990000, Project STR222 – Rehabilitation and Preservation of Major Roadways.

BACKGROUND—

On October 25, 2004, by Roll Call No. 04-2273, the City Council authorized the City Manager to submit an application to IDOT for STP funds for resurfacing the one-way pair streets of Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway and 19th Street from University Avenue to Mondamin Avenue. This funding request was subsequently approved, and IDOT has prepared an agreement for the proposed improvement, which



consists of repair and preparation of the existing roadway and resurfacing with hot mix asphalt. This project will be constructed in the summer of 2006.
