SUBJECT—

Approving and authorizing the execution of Iowa Department of Transportation (IDOT) Agreement for Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway Resurfacing from Mondamin Avenue to Hickman Road.

SYNOPSIS—

The Iowa Department of Transportation has proposed an agreement between the City of Des Moines and the Iowa DOT for Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway Resurfacing from Mondamin Avenue to Hickman Road. The total estimated project cost is \$400,000.

The construction costs are eligible for 80% reimbursement by IDOT Surface Transportation Program (STP) Funds, up to a maximum of \$232,000. The City of Des Moines will provide matching funding for construction, design and construction administration services. Total City funding is estimated to be \$168,000.

FISCAL IMPACT—

Funding for this project is available in the Capital Improvements Program Budget, Account 543060, Fund CP038, Organization ENG990000, Project STR222 – Rehabilitation and Preservation of Major Roadways.

RECOMMENDATION—

Approval.

BACKGROUND—

On October 25, 2004, by Roll Call Number 04-2273, the City Council authorized the City Manager to submit an application to IDOT for STP funds for resurfacing Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway from Mondamin Avenue to Hickman Road. This funding request was subsequently approved, and IDOT has prepared an agreement for the proposed improvement, which consists of repair and preparation of the existing roadway and resurfacing with hot mix asphalt. This project will be constructed in the summer of 2006.
