AGENDA HEADING:

Approving purchase of a one-ton dump body truck through the state contract to replace an existing like unit to be used by the Park and Recreation Department, \$27,256.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval to purchase a one-ton dump body truck through the state contract to replace an existing like unit in the Horticulture Maintenance Division of the Park and Recreation Department. The unit being replaced is a 1995 model that meets the established criteria for replacement by age and condition. This unit will be auctioned at the annual Public Works Department vehicle and equipment auction.
