AGENDA HEADING:

Approval of Supportive Housing Program (SHP) Grant Agreement Amendment with the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).

SYNOPSIS:

City Council approval of SHP Grant Agreement Amendment by and between HUD and the City of Des Moines for supplemental funding for local homeless programs to address service gaps. The amendment extends the contract period from August 1, 2006 to February 28, 2007.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$227,468

Funding Source: HUD/SHP

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

On behalf of the City, the Housing Services Department submitted an application to HUD for SHP funding to provide supplemental funding to address service gaps in local homeless programs in Des Moines and Polk County. As the applicant, the City is responsible for the overall management and administration of the grant, including drawdowns, fund distribution and reporting to HUD.

On December 19, 2005, by Roll Call No. 05-2993, the City Council approved a 2004 SHP Renewal Grant Agreement with HUD, in the amount of \$227,468 for implementation of the House of Mercy SHP Project. HUD has forwarded a grant agreement amendment that extends the contract period from August 1, 2006 to February 28, 2007. The grant agreement amendment requires Council approval and the Mayor's signature.
