Construction of 15" - 24" diameter RCP storm sewers, manholes, intakes, pavement removal and replacement, traffic control, driveways, sodding, and miscellaneous associated work including cleanup; in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File Nos. 462-045/060, in 7th Street, Washington Avenue, 9th Street, and Jefferson Avenue in Des Moines, Iowa.
