Work on tennis court facilities in five (5) park sites that includes crack repairs, joint repairs, surface repairs, joint sealing, fence repair, replacement of net post footings and finish course on the ten (10) tennis courts, all in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File Nos. 462-035/037, at the following City of Des Moines Parks: Burke Park, E. 7th Street and University Avenue; Columbus Park, SE 2nd Street and Indianola Avenue; Good Park, 17th Street and University Avenue; Grandview Park, E. 32nd Street and Easton Boulevard; Sayers Park, SW 13th Street and Watrous Avenue
