#### **AGENDA HEADING:**

Public hearings regarding the issuance of General Obligation Bonds for the FY 2006-07 Capital Improvement Program.

#### **SYNOPSIS:**

Fourteen public hearings regarding the issuance of General Obligation Bonds for the FY 2006-07 Capital Improvement Program. This is a required step in the process to finance the purchase and construction of projects totaling \$39,218,750.

#### **FISCAL IMPACT:**

Amount: \$39,855,000, made up of \$39,218,750 project costs and \$636,250 issuance expenses, plus interest.

Funding Source: Fiscal Year 2006-07 Operating Budget:

- Property Tax Debt Service Levy Debt Service Fund, Series 2006X FIN905500 to FIN906500, Page 204.
- Tax Increment Financing Metro Center District SP370 FIN909105, Page 309.
- Tax Increment Financing Southeast Agricultural District SP370 FIN909108, Page 309.

#### **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

A public hearing must be held prior to any borrowing by the City. This hearing will allow for the consideration of bonding for the FY 2006-07 Capital Improvements Program (CIP) that was approved by City Council on March 6, 2006. Specific projects to be financed are detailed in the attached list of Projects by Category, and are summarized by category as follows:

A second listing is attached to show the projects included in each of fourteen public hearings. The projects are assigned a designation of Essential Corporate Purpose (ECP) or General Corporate Purpose (GCP) according to the requirements of Iowa statute. These designations determine whether or not the borrowing is subject to referendum or reverse referendum. None of the projects require a referendum, but all projects, with the exception of those included in hearing ECP-1, are subject to reverse referendum. A reverse referendum can be initiated by the filing of a petition signed by 10% of voters from the last regular municipal election.

At the workshop on April 20, 2006, staff reviewed with Council projects that may be dependent on private donations or other unconfirmed funding sources. Staff is recommending the following three changes based on that review:

- 1. Skate Park—PKS164 (Recommended CIP, Parks Improvements, page 24): Because no private funds have been raised to date, and a site has not been determined, staff recommends postponing this project's funding (\$700,000) for one year.
- 2. Ingersoll Streetscape Improvements 28<sup>th</sup> 31<sup>st</sup> Streets—STR221 (Recommended CIP, Street Improvements, page 24): Because \$200,000 of private donations have already been secured, staff recommends proceeding with scheduled bonding for this project. However, because the MPO portion of funding for this project will not be received for several years, staff recommends increasing the 2006 G. O. Bond allocation by \$150,000. This change will help the project, and private fundraising efforts, build momentum.
- 3. In response to questions raised at the April 10, 2006 Council meeting regarding FY07 funding for the Neighborhood Finance Corporation (NFC), staff confirmed that the NFC is only entitled to \$1,000,000 in FY07, even though \$1,300,000 was budgeted. The bond issue will therefore be reduced by \$300,000.

The net decrease to the G. O. bond issues for these three revisions will be \$850,000.

At the workshop, Council also reviewed project useful lives as they relate to bond repayment schedules. Staff recommends maintaining the Level Debt repayment option that has been used in the past in order to provide a consistent amount of debt service and to limit the tax rate in the near term. In using this method, the City should also seek additional revenue sources in the future that can be directed toward earlier retirement of debt.

The Council will be asked on May 8, 2006 to approve the bond structure, amount and sale date. The bond sale is tentatively scheduled for Wednesday, May 31, which will require a special Council meeting, but follows a strategy of scheduling bond sales apart from Mondays and Tuesdays in an effort to benefit from greater interest on the part of potential underwriters and investors.
