## **AGENDA HEADING:**

Approving an amendment to the Schedule of Fees as it applies to the operation of certain refrigeration equipment under Chapter 46 of the Municipal Code.

### **SYNOPSIS:**

A revision of Chapter 46 of the Municipal Code, at Section 1 (C) (27), was inadvertently omitted when the 2003 International Fire Code was adopted by the Council on August 8, 2005. Another item on the June 5, 2006 Council agenda recommends that the Code be updated. Assuming Council approves the ordinance change, this action amends the Schedule of Fees so that it accurately references the 2003 Code. The amount of the fee does not change.

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The current Schedule of Fess references a previous edition of the International Fire Code that requires a permit for the operation of a refrigeration unit or system containing any amount of group 2 or 3 refrigerant or those with group 1 refrigerant and a compressor rating of 100 horsepower or more.

The 2003 Code, as adopted, states, "Refrigerant equipment. To operate a refrigeration unit or system having a refrigerant circuit containing more than 220 pounds (100kg) of Group A1 or 30 pounds (14kg) of any other group refrigerant."

The action amends the Schedule of Fees to accurately reflect the 2003 International Fire Code.
