ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The City Council previously approved the original bond for infrastructure improvements for the Meadowlands Plat 2 in the amount of \$95,292. The developer has requested a reduction in the required bond since much of the required improvements have been made. The Engineering Department has confirmed that much of the required work has been completed, but the amount of work remaining needs to have bond in the amount of \$25,823 to make sure the remaining improvements will be in place when the development in the plat is completed.
