AGENDA HEADING:

Approval of the Community Services Block Grant (CSBG) COMMUNITY ACTION PLAN (application) for the 2006-2007 CSBG Program Year.

SYNOPSIS:

Approval of the Community Services Block Grant (CSBG) COMMUNITY ACTION PLAN (application) made to the Iowa Department of Human Rights/ Division of Community Action Agencies for the City of Des Moines Community Services Program for low-income persons from October 1, 2006 to September 30, 2007.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$526,864 (revenues)

<u>Funding Source</u>: Community Services Block Grant (CSBG) through the Iowa Department of Human Rights/ Division of Community Action Agencies, deposited to the FY07 Operating Budget, Community Services Block Grants – SP027 CDD049900, CDD2007001, page 314.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

CSBG provides funding for the City's Community Action Agency with services delivered through the Community Development Department's Community Services Division. Services are delivered through the downtown office in the Armory Building and the Forest Avenue, Logan, and Pioneer-Columbus Community Services site offices. The Low-income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP), Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), and United Way also provide funding to the City's Community Action efforts.

The Community Services Division operates as the Community Action Agency for the City of Des Moines. It is charged with providing services to the City's low-income families and trying to address and eliminate causes of poverty. The City became a public Community Action Agency (CAA) in 1977.

The beginnings of Community Action can be found in the signing of the federal Equal Opportunity Act in 1964. There are now 1,000 Community Action Agencies in the U.S. The City of Des Moines is one of eighteen Community Action Agencies serving Iowa.
