AGENDA HEADING:

2006/2007 Salt Contract for Snow and Ice Control Operations

SYNOPSIS:

The Public Works Department has joined with 17 other public agencies in a combined bid for salt for the 2006-2007 snow and ice control season. Nine bid packages were mailed, and three bids were received. Hutchinson Salt Company (Charles J. Dix, Vice President, P.O. Box 346, Paola, KS 66071) was the low bid, at a cost of \$37.60 per ton pre-season (July 1, 2006 to November 1, 2006) cost and \$38.60 per ton after November 1, 2006. Staff recommends the purchase of 2,000 tons, which is the limit of available storage at the Public Works Supply Yard, at \$37.60 per ton and 6,000 tons over the course of the remaining winter months as needed, at \$38.60 per ton, for a total of \$306,800. This year's total projected cost is approximately 1% higher than last year.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The City of Des Moines' Snow and Ice Control Program includes the use of salt and salt/sand mixtures throughout the winter season. An estimated 8,000 tons of salt are used each year. To obtain more favorable bids, the City of Des Moines has participated in a joint bid process with the City of West Des Moines, Polk County, and 15 other public agencies. Because of the larger quantity of salt involved, a more competitive bid of \$37.60 per ton (pre-season) and \$38.60 per ton (after November 1, 2006) was received. Therefore, approval to purchase 8,000 tons at the bid prices is recommended.
