AGENDA HEADING:

Submitting out-of-state travel requests for Douglas P. Philiph, Steve Schinkel, and Kimberly Piper.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval for out-of-state travel requests listed below. The approval for Steve Schinkel is to amend a trip previously approved by Council on July 10, 2006. The destination of the training location has changed from Sterling, VA to Moyoc, NC and the estimated cost of the trip has changed from \$2,097 to \$2,449 (funding source remains unchanged).

Douglas P. Philiph (R-0), Assistant City Attorney, to Boston, Massachusetts from October 13-17, 2006 (\$1,875), to attend the International Association of Chiefs of Police Annual Conference and the Legal Officers Section Seminar, which will provide information about current legal and other issues affecting law enforcement.

Steve Schinkel (NR-1), Senior Police Officer, Moyoc, North Carolina from October 15-21, 2006 (\$2,449), to attend Heckler & Koch rifle armorer class, which will provide training as an armorer enabling him to conduct preventive maintenance, repair weapons and receive certified parts to keep weapons functioning under manufacturers warranty. This request is to amend travel previously approved by Council on July 10, 2006.

Kimberly Piper (NR-0), Systems Operations Administrative Coordinator, Chicago, Illinois from October 29 - November 3, 2006 (\$2,560), to attend Business Objects training courses on Crystal Reports Design 1 & 2.

The amount budgeted for travel in Fiscal Year (FY) 2007 is \$328,255. The amount expended for travel in FY 2007 as of September 5, 2006 is \$29,573.
