ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

On August 19, 2003, the Housing Services Department received approval for its application to dispose of 394 Public Housing units at fair market value via a public bid. According to federal regulations, sales can be negotiated with a specific buyer when there is a commensurate public benefit.

For many years, Preservation ROSE, LLLP and John Lewis Community Services (Developer) have provided affordable housing in Iowa while meeting the requirements of federally funded housing programs. They have the ability to meet the requirements of DMMHA's disposition plan.

After the single family homes/properties have been acquired and rehabbed, Preservation ROSE, LLLP intends to use them in its *Renter to Owner Savings Equity (ROSE)* program for income-limited households.
