AGENDA HEADING:

Authorizing the Des Moines Municipal Housing Agency (DMMHA) to negotiate with Community Homes, L.P. for the disposition sales of 5301 and 5307 SW 9th St., 1218-1220, 1219-1221, 1225-1227, 1231-1233, 1237-1239 and 1236-1238 Highview Drive, 4225-4227 and 4231-4233 Hull Avenue, 2419-2421 and 2425-2427 E. 36th Ct., 4125-4127, 4137-4139, and 4141-4143 Dubuque Avenue, 4209-4211 Ovid Avenue, 1108-1110 and 1114-1116 SE McKinley Avenue, 6211-6213 and 6215-6217 SW 14th St.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval for the Des Moines Municipal Housing Agency to negotiate with Community Homes, L.P. for the disposition sales of 5301 and 5307 9th SW 9th St., 1218-1220, 1219-1221, 1225-1227, 1231-1233, 1237-1239 and 1236-1238 Highview Drive, 4225-4227 and 4231-4233 Hull Avenue, 2419-2421 and 2425-2427 E. 36th Ct., 4125-4127, 4137-4139, and 4141-4143 Dubuque Avenue, 4209-4211 Ovid Avenue, 1108-1110 and 1114-1116 SE McKinley Avenue, 6211-6213 and 6215-6217 SW 14th St. To be used for affordable rental units following rehabilitation.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: Total sale price for these 44 units is \$1,556,250.

<u>Funding Source</u>: Fiscal Year 2006-07 Operating Budget, Des Moines Public Housing Agency Fund, Housing Services – Maintenance, SP350 HSG070000, page 225.

Revenue derived from the sale of these properties will be allocated accordingly:

- 75% Affordable Housing Endowment Fund
- 25% Physical Improvements to existing Manors

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The Housing Services Department received approval for its application to dispose of 394 Public Housing units at Fair Market Value, via a public bid on August 19, 2003. Where there is a commensurate public benefits, according to federal regulations, sales can be negotiated with a specific buyer.

Community Homes, L.P. has a long history of providing affordable housing in Iowa; therefore meeting the requirements of federally funded housing programs and has the ability to meet the requirements of DMMHA's disposition plan. Community Homes, L.P. intends to use these properties for affordable

rental units for households below 80% of HUD median income guidelines, after the properties are acquired and fully rehabbed.
