#### **AGENDA HEADING:**

Hearing on South Union Street & Park Avenue Storm Sewer Improvements: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as Reilly Construction Company, Inc., Chris R. Reilly, President, \$209,856.

#### **SYNOPSIS:**

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the South Union Street & Park Avenue Storm Sewer Improvements and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project provides for the construction of a new storm sewer to replace an open drainage way in the northwest quadrant of the intersection. This improvement will provide increased flow carrying capacity near this intersection, which will mitigate flooding and drainage problems and also reduce maintenance problems.

#### **FISCAL IMPACT:**

Amount: \$209,856 Construction Contract (Construction Estimate - \$230,600)

<u>Funding Source</u>: 2006-2007 CIP, Page Storm-8, Crawford Creek - Watershed Improvements, STE074, Storm Water Utility Funds

#### **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

On October 23, 2006, under Roll Call No. 06-2063, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the South Union Street & Park Avenue Storm Sewer Improvements. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for construction of the South Union Street & Park Avenue Storm Sewer Improvements, 08-2007-002. The improvement includes constructing approximately 350 LF of new 72" reinforced concrete pipe in the northwest quadrant of the intersection of South Union Street and Park Avenue, also including relocation of conflicting utilities including sanitary sewer, reconstruction of street, driveway, and sidewalk pavements; site seeding or sodding, and other incidental items; in accordance with the contract documents, including Plans File Nos. 465-040/046, on South Union Street and Park Avenue, Des Moines, Iowa.

The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsible, responsive bid for the construction of said improvement was submitted by Reilly Construction Company, Inc., Chris R. Reilly, President, 110 Main Street, PO Box 99, Ossian, IA, 52161 in the amount of \$209,856. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available as stated above.
