AGENDA HEADING:

Authorize Disposition Sale of 2333 SE 17th Street to ANAWIM d/b/a/ Anawim Housing.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval to sell 2333 SE 17th Street to ANAWIM d/b/a/ Anawim Housing.

FISCAL IMPACT:

<u>Amount</u>: \$94,000 revenue (100% of the HUD approved Fair Market Value)

<u>Funding Source</u>: FY2006-07 Operating Budget, Municipal Housing Agency, Housing Services, Maintenance, SP350 HSG070000, pg. 225.

The proceeds from the sale will be used accordingly:

- Affordable Housing Endowment Fund (75%)
- Physical Improvements to existing Manors (25%)

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The Housing Services Department received approval for its application to dispose of 394 Public Housing units at Fair Market Value, via a public bid on August 19, 2003. Where there is a commensurate public benefit, according to federal regulations, sales can be negotiated with a specific buyer.

Anawim Housing, an Iowa nonprofit corporation has a long history of providing affordable housing in the City of Des Moines, of meeting the requirements of federally funded housing programs and has the ability to meet the requirements of the Des Moines Municipal Housing Agency's (DMMHA) disposition plan. Anawim housing, intends to use this property as a project manager's residential unit in conjunction with the Pioneer Woods affordable housing project. That project will provide for affordable housing for households below 80% of HUD medium income guidelines.

DMMHA has received HUD approval for this negotiated sale at full Fair Market Value with no restrictive covenant for this unit only.
