## AGENDA HEADING:

Approving an amendment to the Procedural Rules of the Neighborhood Revitalization Board (NRB), to create a standardized process for the election of officers.

### SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approving the amendment to create a more standardized process for the election of NRB officers.

# FISCAL IMPACT: NONE

### **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

The Neighborhood Revitalization Board was created on July 1, 1997, to serve as an advisory board for the city council on neighborhood issues. There are three officer positions on the NRB: chair, vice-chair, and secretary. Currently officers are elected on an annual basis. The format of election varies annually and has never been written into the Procedural Rules of the Neighborhood Revitalization Board.

This action creates a standardized format for the election of NRB officers. Under this proposal, the vicechair will automatically be nominated for the position of chair and the secretary will automatically be nominated for the position of vice chair. Open nominations will also be accepted for chair, vicechair, and secretary positions.
