AGENDA HEADING:

Approval of the Community Services Block Grant (CSBG) contract (Community Action Plan) for the 2006-2007 CSBG Program Year.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of the Community Services Block Grant (CSBG) contract made to the Iowa Department of Human Rights/Division of Community Action Agencies for the City of Des Moines Community Services Program for low-income persons from October 1, 2006, to September 30, 2007.

Amount: \$526,864 (revenue)

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

CSBG provides funding for the City's Community Action Agency with services delivered through the Community Development Department's Community Services Division. Services are delivered through the downtown office in the Armory Building and the Forest Avenue, Logan, and Pioneer-Columbus Community Services site offices. The Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP), Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), and United Way also provide funding for the City's Community Action efforts.

The Community Services Division operates as the Community Action Agency for the City of Des Moines. It is charged with providing services to the City's low-income families and trying to address and eliminate causes of poverty. The City became a public Community Action Agency (CAA) in 1977.

The beginnings of Community Action can be found in the signing of the federal Equal Opportunity Act in 1964. There are now 1,000 Community Action Agencies in the U.S. The City of Des Moines is one of eighteen Community Action Agencies serving Iowa.
