AGENDA HEADING:

Approval of grant agreements with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for funding of the City's 2007 HUD Consolidated Plan.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend City Council approval of grant agreements by and between HUD and the City of Des Moines whereby the City will receive grant awards of HOME Investment Partnership Program (HOME) and Emergency Shelter Grant (ESG) funding for implementation of the 2007 HUD Consolidated Plan for the period of January 1, 2007 to December 31, 2007.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

On November 20, 2006, by Roll Call No. 06-2324, the City Council authorized and directed the City Manager to submit the 2007 HUD Consolidated Plan to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. HUD has now forwarded grant agreements for HOME and ESG funds for funding of the City's 2007 HUD Consolidated Plan. The grant agreements require Council approval and the Mayor's signature.
